

ELIGIBILITY FOR HEALTH SERVICES

Rutgers University staff and students are ELIGIBLE for services as follows:

- Full-time students (12 or more credits) who have paid the health fee (with tuition)
- Part-time students upon payment of the health fee
- Spouses or sole domestic partners of Rutgers Students, who have paid the health fee
- Pals and other international students who have paid the health fee
- Alumni, on a fee-for-service basis, for up to one year following graduation
- Employees for pre-employment physicals, at charge to the department
- Employees for triage and referral in case of work-related injury or illness
- Students under 18 years of age, otherwise eligible for services, who are emancipated minors, or who have parental informed consent

The following are NOT ELIGIBLE for health services at Newark Health Center:

- Rutgers University students, spouses, sole domestic partners, or part-time students who have not paid the health service fees
- Insured dependents of Rutgers University students (children of any age)
- Visitors to the campus (any age)
- Minors and others attending programs on campus, who are not regular Rutgers Students
- Employees with non-work-related health problems.

Eligibility during summer session,

- Full-time students enrolled in the spring semester, and attending summer session may obtain services without additional charge
- Full-time students enrolled in spring semester, but not taking any summer courses may utilize health centers upon payment of the summer fee
- Students attending summer classes, not eligible during the spring semester, may utilize health services, but do not have any insurance coverage and are required to pay for testing ordinarily covered by the health insurance plan.
- Students not enrolled in summer session, nor eligible for health services during the previous spring semester, may be seen on a fee-for-service basis.

Non-eligible individuals, as noted above, should be referred to their family physician or the nearest hospital emergency room, when immediate health care is required. If patient is a minor, a parent or guardian should be contacted immediately to make arrangements, with assistance as needed.

NON ELIGIBLE Rutgers University students, spouses, or domestic partners may access health services by payment of the health services fee prior to the visit. Fee may be payable by cash, check, money order or credit card. Charges which are noted in the Insurance booklet or upon request are subject to change.
